HISTORY OF THE WORLD CONFERENCE OF MAYORS, INC., (WCM) (The United Nations of Cities)

In April 1984, The Honorable Johnny Ford, then Mayor of Tuskegee, Alabama, USA, and President of the National Conference of Black Mayor s, Inc. (NCBM), convened mayors from the United States, Asia, the African continent, and the Caribbean Islands, in St. Louis, Missouri, USA, and organized The World Conference of Mayors, Inc. (WCM). This historic meeting occurred during the NCBM Annual Meeting, and Ford and other African American mayors throughout the United States enthusiastically welcomed the international mayors to St. Louis.

From the beginning, it was agreed that the NCBM and Union Des Villes Africans (UVA), the organization of African Mayors, would be the two founding organizations, Members of both organizations would automatically become members of the new World Conference of Mayors, Inc. From that organizational meeting, Ford was elected Founding President, along with a Board of Directors, and staff headed by Michelle Kourouma. In the fall of 1984, The World Conference of Mayors was incorporated by Attorney George Howell in the state of Georgia. The WCM first Annual Convention and Board Meeting was convened in Monrovia, Liberia, West Africa. The World Conference of Mayors' march toward becoming a United Nations of Cities had begun.

This global organization of Mayors from throughout the world is a non - profit, non-partisan organization. The primary objective of The World Conference of Mayors is to stimulate positive and constructive relations between mayors internationally, based on interlocking interests and concerns. Through a network of international municipal associations, mayors and units of local governments, The World Conference of Mayors plans, designs, and manages an international, intergovernmental communication system, through its promotion of seven fundamental goals, its "7 T's": Trust, Trade, Tourism, Technology, Treasury, Training and Twin city programs and services between

HISTORY OF THE HISTORIC BLACK TOWNS AND SETTLEMENTS ALLIANCE, INC.

By The Honorable Johnny Ford

In 1881, Lewis Adams (Town) and Booker T. Washington (Gown) collaborated to found Tuskegee Normal and Industrial Institute, now Tuskegee University, and Tuskegee Institute, Alabama (A historic Black settlement surrounding the school, created by Dr. Washington, that though never incorporated, was granted its own zip code: 36088). A seed for the collaboration between "Town" and "Gown" was thereby planted in central Alabama. In 1901, at the annual meeting of the National Business League (NBL), Dr. Booker T. Washington called upon the Mayor S. L. Davis, elected in 1899 as the first Mayor of Hobson City Alabama, the first incorporated all Black town in the state of Alabama, to give the national address, calling upon the African American communities to organize their own towns, settlements, and schools. The seed planted in Tuskegee, in 1881, by 1901 had grown into a national "Tree". By then historic all Black towns had begun to grow. Among them: 1885, Princeville, NC; 1887, Eatonville, FL; 1887 Mound Bayou, MS; 1899, Hobson City, AL; 1901, the community of Grambling, LA, around what would become Grambling University. Now, today there are more than 1,000 historic Black towns and settlements, and more than 100 Historic Black colleges and universities (HBCUs).

In the fall of 2012 then Tuskegee Mayor Johnny Ford, a founder of the Alabama Conference of Black Mayors, and the National Conference of Black Mayors, now the African American Mayors Association, and the founder of The World Conference of Mayors, Inc, was invited by the late Mayor Bruce Mount to visit his town of Eatonville, Florida, which proudly calls itself, "The Town that Freedom Built". Mayor Mount told Mayor Ford about the influence that Dr. Booker T. Washington had had upon Eatonville, and the founding of their historic Hungerford School. Mayor Mount showed Mayor Ford, the name of Dr. Booker T. Washington proudly displayed, along with a quote from Dr. Washington, inscribed on the permanent gate to the historic town of Eatonville. Both Mayor Ford, and Mayor Mount immediately recognized the relationship between Tuskegee and Eatonville. Mayor Mount also introduced Mayor Ford to N.Y. Nathiri, and the Association to Preserve the History of Eatonville, and to the fact that the late, great, author Zora Neale Hurston, had actually been born in Notasulga, Alabama, near Tuskegee. Ford, Mount, and Nathiri recognized immediately the relationship (the historic trail) between Tuskegee Institute, Alabama (Booker T's Town), and Eatonville (Zora's Town).

Mayor Ford, returned to Alabama excited, and decided to nurture the "seed" planted by Dr. Booker T. Washington in 1881, and cultivated in 1901 (NBL) by Mayor S. L. Davis of Hobson City, by hosting an organizational meeting of what would become the Historic Black Towns and Settlements Alliance. He raised the money to cover the cost of the organizational meeting in the spring of 2013 at the Tuskegee Municipal Complex, located in Tuskegee, Alabama, and at the Kellogg Conference Center, located upon the historic campus of Tuskegee University, in Tuskegee Institute Alabama (36088). Mayor Ford invited the following mayors to join Tuskegee Institute, Alabama, in founding an Alliance of Historic Black Towns and Settlements: Eatonville, Florida, Mayor Bruce Mount; Hobson City, Alabama, Mayor Alberta McCrory; Mound Bayou, Mississippi, Mayor Darryl Johnson, and Gramling, Louisiana, Mayor Ed Jones.

The Mayors met. They agreed to organize, and elected Mayor Ford, as the Founding President, and elected Mayor Mount, Mayor McCrory, Mayor Jones, and Mayor Johnson, as co-founders. The Mayors continued to meet, and with the assistance of renown architect, Edward Fly, and Eatonville's N. Y. Nathiri, developed a work program and a strategic plan. The HBTSA was incorporated in 2014, by The World Conference of Mayors General Counsel, noted civil rights icon, Attorney Fred Gray. Thanks to Ed Fly, the HBTSA, once it was incorporated, received a \$10,000.00 grant from the National Trust for Historic Preservation. In 2018, Mayor Ford went to New York and met with the Mellon Foundation and paved the way for Dr. Michelle Robinson, HBTSA VP for Educational Matters, to write the grant that resulted in the receipt of a \$300,000.00 grant, administered by Spelman University for the work of the HBTSA. The rest is history.

The seed that Booker T planted in Tuskegee in 1881, and cultivated in 1901 with his National Negro Business League, has not only "branched" into Booker T's Five Towns, it now serves as a voice for over 1,000 historic towns and settlements across the country. The National Headquarters of the HBTSA is in Tuskegee, AL, (1205 East lakeshore Drive, Tuskegee, AL 36083) This is appropriate because the Black community of Tuskegee was the home base of Booker T. Washington who was responsible for the creation and the survival of so many historically Black towns, cities, and communities

William C. Bell became president and chief executive officer of Casey Family Programs in January 2006. He chairs the Executive Team and is ultimately responsible for the vision, mission, strategies and objectives of the foundation.

Dr. Bell earned his Ph.D. in social welfare from the Graduate Center of the City University of New York, his Master of Social Work degree from Hunter College School of Social Work, and his bachelor's in biology and behavioral science degree from Delta State University.

Public service, honors and professional affiliations

Dr. Bell serves on the board of the Delta State University Foundation. He is a founding member of Cities United and serves on its advisory board. Cities United is a national network of mayors working to reduce violence-related deaths of African American males.

A native of Mississippi, Dr. Bell was recognized in 2017 by the Mississippi Senate, House of Representatives and governor with a Senate Concurrent Resolution for his life of service to the nation's children and families. In 2016, Dr. Bell received the Special Contribution to the Judiciary Award from the King County Washington Women Lawyers for his service to children and families, including those in the child welfare system, and for making our judicial system more accessible to all, regardless of economic status. In 2015, Dr. Bell received the Orgullo de la Comunidad (Pride of our Community) Award from the Coalition for Hispanic Family Services.

The Association of Black Foundation Executives selected Dr. Bell as its 2014 James A. Joseph Lecturer for his visionary leadership and stewardship of progressive philanthropic ideals that advance the organization's mission. Dr. Bell was named the 2012 Outstanding Alumnus of the Year by Delta State University and was inducted into its Alumni Hall of Fame and into Omicron Delta Kappa, a national leadership honor society. The Robert F. Kennedy Children's Action Corps awarded Dr. Bell its 2012 Embracing the Legacy Award for his tireless work to prevent child abuse and neglect and build communities of hope for America's vulnerable children. He was honored in 2010 by New York City's CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) for his contributions and lifelong commitment to improving the lives of children in foster care.

Dr. Bell's many other awards and honors include; the 2005 Valeria Bullard Black Administrator of the Year Award from the Black Administrators in Child Welfare; and the 2004 Betsey R. Rosenbaum Award for Excellence in Public Child Welfare Administration from the National Association for Public Child Welfare Administrators. In 2003, he was inducted into the Hunter College Alumni Hall of Fame.



16th President/CEO
The National Business League (NBL)

Implementing no-nonsense Ancient African principles towards the pursuit of economic freedom, DR. KENNETH L. HARRIS has spent his distinguished career fervently advocating for Black and indigenousness businesses all around the world. An economist, international scholar, and revered Black business historian, he assumed leadership of the National Business League in 2017, then proceeded to cast a \$20 million lifeline of capital support to Black-owned businesses disrupted by the catastrophic Covid-19 pandemic. Years prior in 2005, he launched the International Detroit Black Expo, Inc., an acclaimed annual showcase that hosted more than 1,000 Black exhibitors from around the globe, reaching 300,000 consumers. As founder, president and CEO of the Michigan Black Chamber of Commerce, Dr. Harris built one of the largest Black chambers in the nation with more than 36,200 members state-wide. He was also elected to the Detroit Charter Commission by 40,149 votes in a highly contested citywide race featuring 54 candidates in the city of Detroit.

Dr. Harris holds a B.A. in Psychology and an M.A. in Counseling/Clinical Psychology from Georgia's Clark Atlanta University. He received his Doctor of Humane Letters from Detroit's Lewis College of Business, in addition to an Educational Specialist (EDS) degree from Wayne State University. He earned a dual Ph.D. at Michigan State University in African American and African Studies and Economics with a specialization in Business and Entrepreneurship from the Eli Broad School of Business. Dr. Harris is the 16th National President/CEO of the National Business League, the country's first and largest trade association for Black businesses and professionals, founded by Black business legend Booker T. Washington in 1900, supporting 120,000+ members nationwide, with 125+ Fortune 500 corporate partners and manages local city chapters throughout all 50 states and internationally. The National Business League is headquartered in Washington, D.C., since 1966, with Regional Offices in Atlanta, GA, Detroit, MI and Los Angeles, CA.
